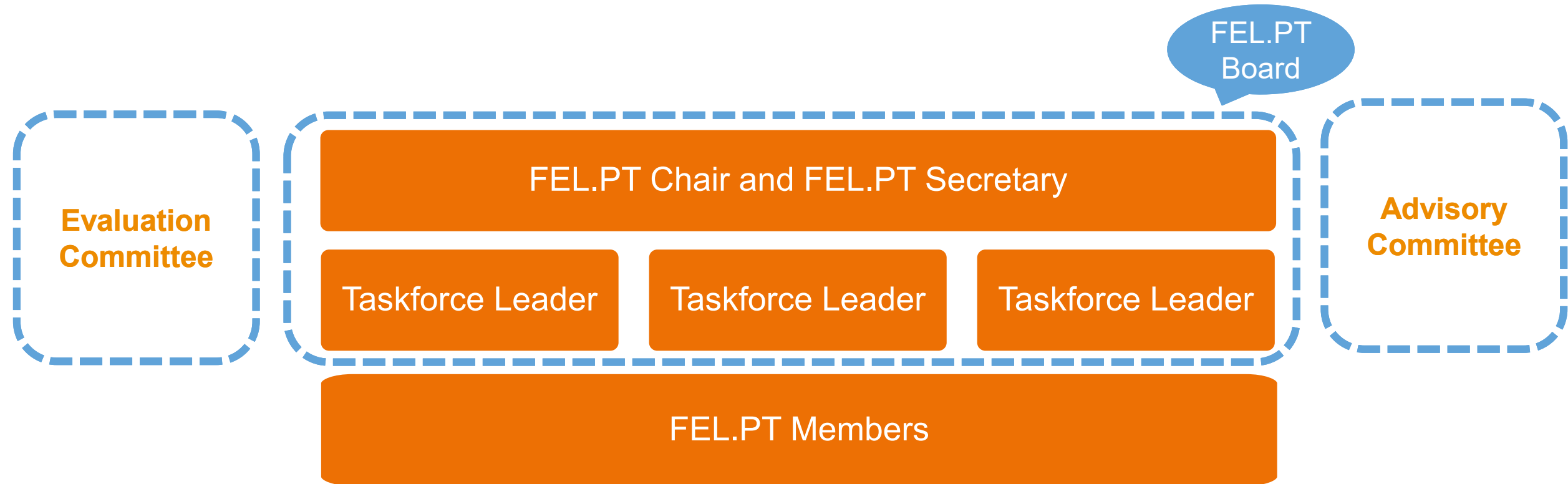
Within our mission we share common values:

FEL.PT Chair

The role of the chairperson is to represent the programme and coordinate its activities. His/her responsibilities include to act as a spokesperson and represent the FEL.PT community, to take responsibilities and coordinate the work of the FEL.PT board, and to facilitate governance and meetings.

FEL.PT Secretary

The Secretary is responsible for monitoring the execution of activities and for assisting the FEL.PT community in general and the FEL.PT board in particular. His/her responsibilities include to oversee the execution of activities approved by the FEL.PT board.

FEL.PT Taskforce Leaders

The role of the taskforce leaders is to communicate team status and task accomplishments with the board. The taskforce leader should coordinate team logistics, provide team leadership, set milestones for projects and provide guidance to members as needed to accomplish projects.

The Evaluation Committee

The Evaluation Committee ensures the quality of the programme by selecting and inviting the most appropriate participants to join the programme and facilitating their active involvement.

The Advisory Committee

The Advisory Committee is a group of experience professionals with the mission of assisting and advising the FEL.PT Board.

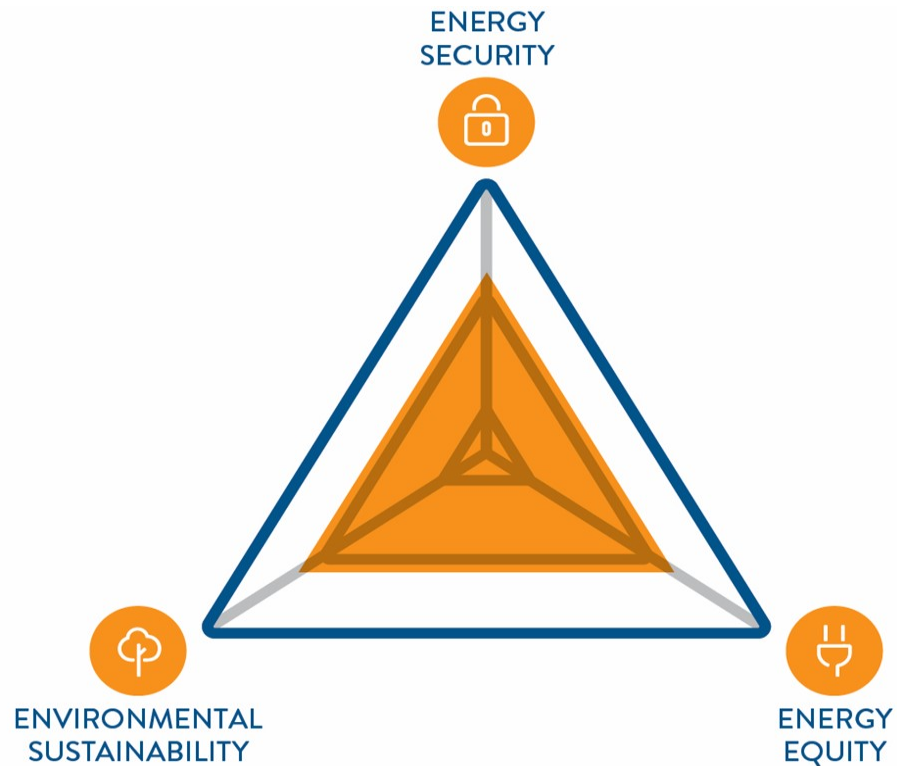
FEL.PT is all about participation

FEL.PT and FELs Events

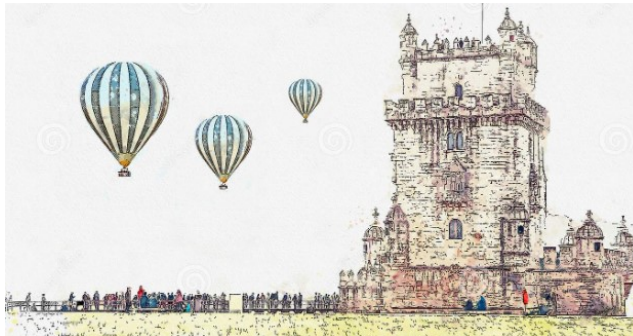
- 1) There will be a FEL.PT Summit each year – organized by FEL.PT members and Portuguese MC (APE);
